Each employee who works at least 30 hours per week, or more, shall be one (1) FTE, and the equivalent FTE for part-time employees (all those employees who work less than 30 hours per week Shall be equal to one FTE for every two part-time employees. All calculations of the number employees, for the purposes of this Ordinance, shall be calculated based on the number of employees during any Commercial, Industrial or Governmental Users' peak month of employment. Provided however, Employee shall not include Remote Worker(s).
